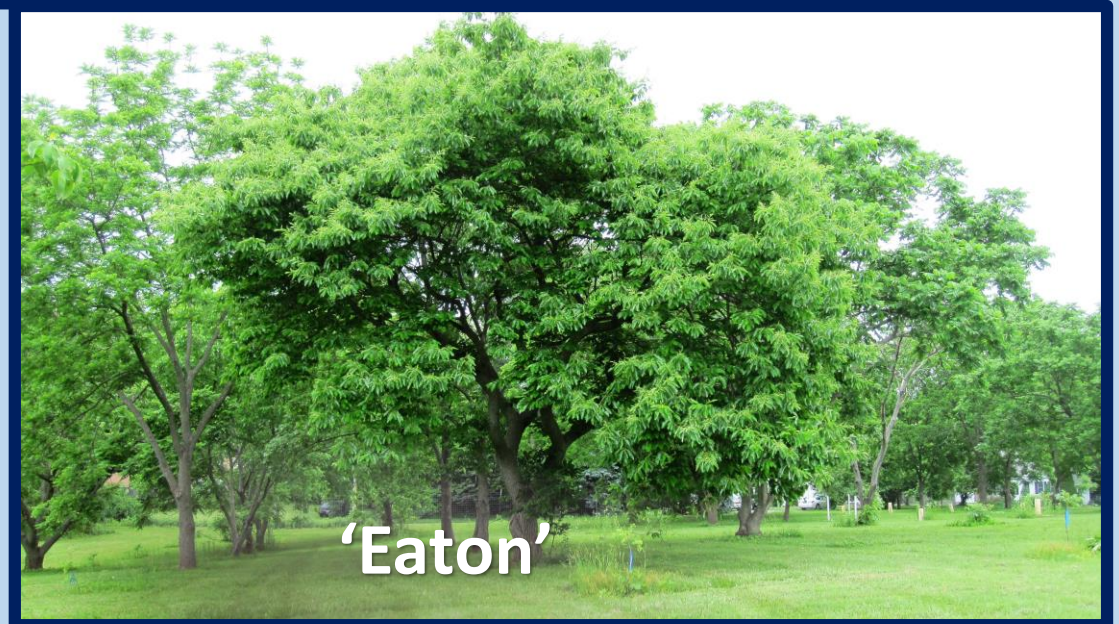

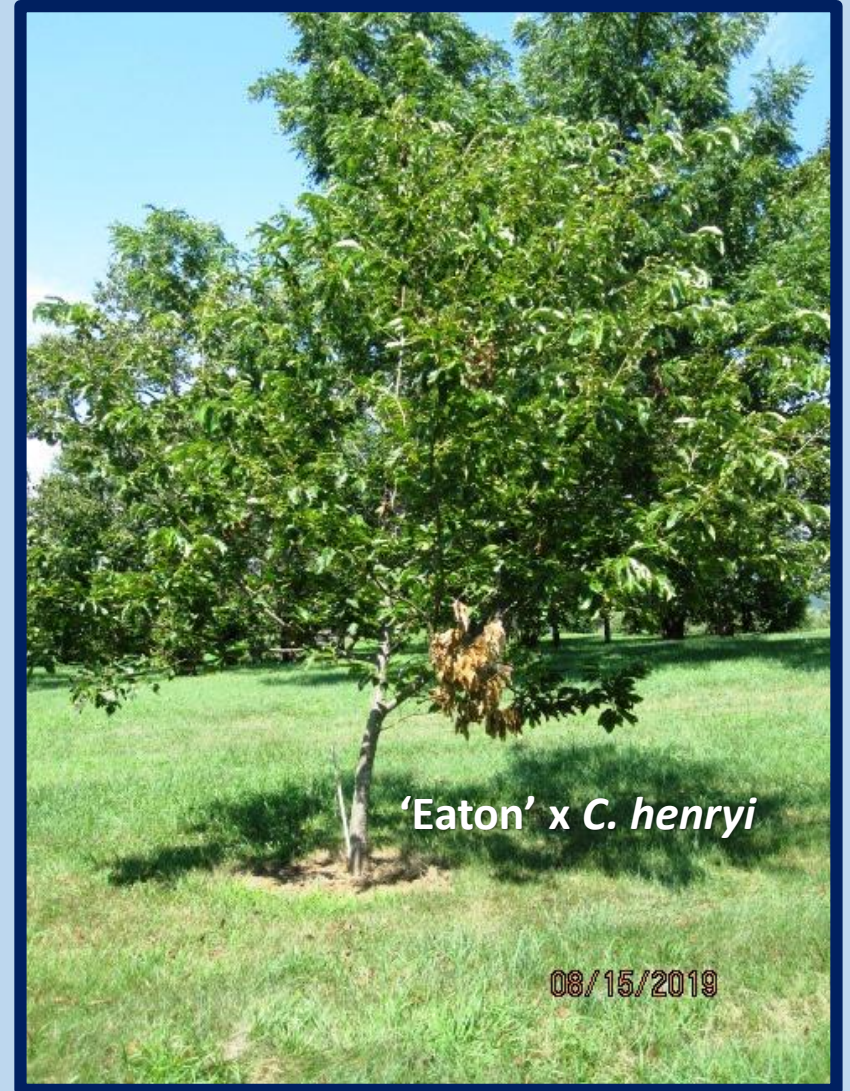

First crosses, commercial trees x *C. henryi*, 2011

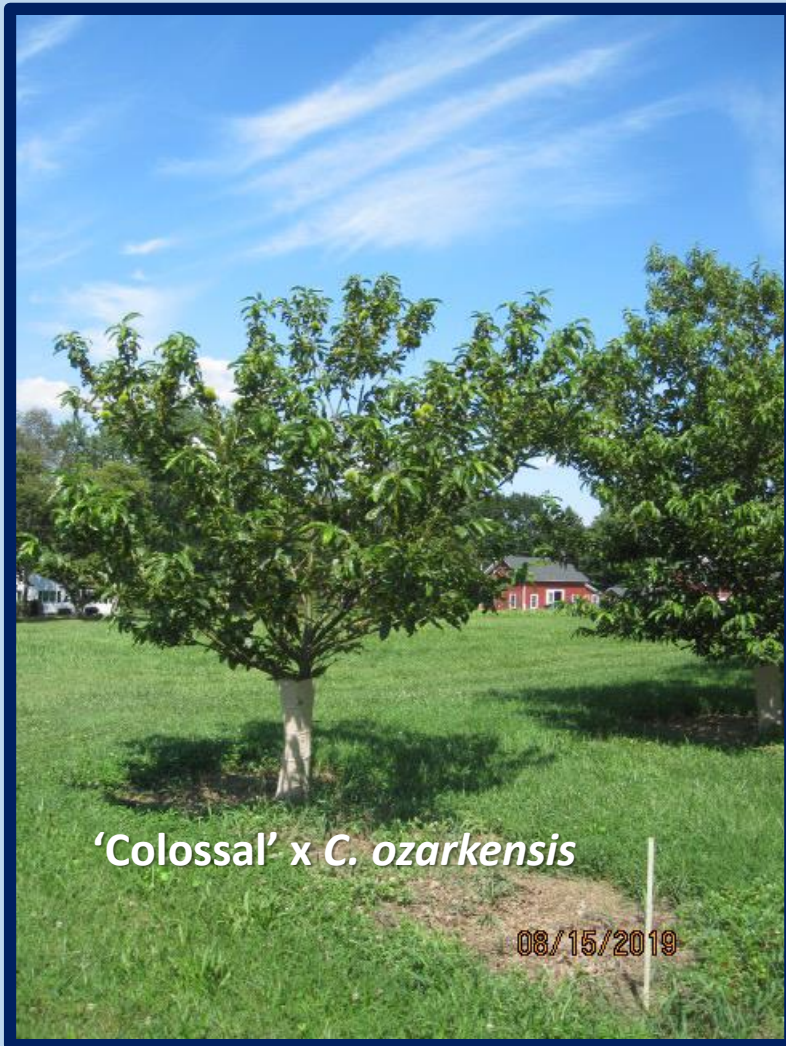
